

Application Process:

Application forms can be collected from the school or downloaded from our website (www.saanma.com) from the Saanma Junior and High School page. Completed forms should be submitted to the school on or before May 31 of each respective year. All applications should be accompanied by two passport sized photo, registration fee (BDS\$50.00), immunisation card, national identification Card/Passport and copies of previous school report cards (where applicable).
